Competition Rules

Reminder: Five "must do's" for a school to be eligible to advance to the national event (as listed in competition rules):

- 1. Prior to the start of the conference, be a chapter in good standing, meaning:
 - a. Annual report submitted
 - b. Dues paid and current
 - c. (CONCRETE CANOE ONLY) Must submit full annual report form and score in the top 2/3 of annual reports
- 2. Participate in the conference technical paper competition
- 3. Be on time and participate in the business meeting
- 4. Place well enough in the actual competition(s)
- 5. Behave professionally and courteously
