1.0 Event Description

The Scavenger Hunt will begin on Thursday, April 12, 2018 at 8:00am and end on Saturday, April 14, 2016 at 12:00pm. Teams will work together to complete as many tasks as possible on the Scavenger Hunt List in order to earn as most points as possible.

2.0 Objective

To encourage teamwork and underclassmen participation.

3.0 Participant Rules

- Each school may only enter one team.
- Each team must consist of at least 2 members.
- Each team member must be a registered participant of the PSWC 2018.
- Each team must have at least one underclassman.
- Each team must have a designated captain.

4.0 General Rules

1. Teams must download the Scavenger Hunt List the morning of the event available on the conference website.
2. The Scavenger Hunt List will have various tasks; each task will be assigned a task number.
3. Teams are required to bring at least one digital camera or camera phone. Teams will use them to take photos of themselves as proof of completing each task.
4. Teams may submit only one photo per task. Each photo must be named as follows:
 - "SCHOOL ABBREVIATION_TASK NUMBER". For example: "NAU_3" All photos must be in .JPEG format.
5. Teams are responsible for properly submitting and labeling their photos.
6. Teams must upload each photo to their school's designated folder in the Dropbox file, which will be sent out in Mailer 3.
7. Any photos that are not labeled correctly will not be judged.
8. It is the team's responsibility to ensure their submittal is in the correct/readable format.
9. Teams may begin submitting their DropBox files at 8:00 am on Thursday, April 12, 2018.



10. Any submittals after 12:01 pm on Saturday, April 14, 2018 will not be accepted.
11. All final submittal deadlines/requirements will be printed on the Scavenger Hunt List.
Further instructions and rules will also be printed on the Scavenger Hunt List.
12. All submissions will receive a timestamp upon submission, which will be used in the case of a tie to determine a winner.
13. Teams must wear a shirt that represents their University in all photo submissions.
